Statement of Faith

1. **Inspiration of Scriptures** We believe in the verbal inspiration of the Bible, both the Old and New Testaments, by the Holy Spirit as originally given; they are the final authority for our faith and life (II Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 4:12).
2. **God** We believe in one God revealed in three coequal, distinct persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit (Matthew 3:16-17, 28:19-20; Ephesians 2:18).
3. **Man** We believe that man in his natural state is a sinner, lost, undone, without hope, and without God (Ephesians 2:1-2; Romans 3:23).
4. **Divinity and Humanity of Christ** We believe that Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God who by His incarnation and virgin birth took upon Himself the form of man and became the God-Man. In the one person of Christ, there are two natures, human and divine, each in its completeness and integrity. They are distinguishable but indivisible, so that He is fully man and fully God. He lived a sinless life and became the only sacrifice for the sins of the world (Ephesians 1:3-5; Romans 5:1-11; Acts 12:4; Peter 1:18-19).
5. **Bodily Resurrection** We believe in the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ (Luke 24:38-43; John 20:24-29)
6. **Salvation** We believe that the terms of salvation are repentance towards God for sin and a personal heart-felt faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, as the one and only way to salvation and eternal life, which results in regeneration. This salvation is entirely by grace and not by works (Ephesians 2:6-10; Romans 5:1; Acts 3:19-20).

7. **Second Coming** We believe in the visible, bodily return of Christ to this earth to judge the world and to claim His Bride (I Thessalonians 4:13-18; Revelations 1:7).
8. **Church** We believe that the church is Christ's spiritual body on earth today. It consists of born-again believers and has both universal and local expressions (Matthew 16:18; Acts 20:28).
9. **Heaven and Hell** We believe in the doctrines of eternal punishment for the lost and eternal bliss and service for the saved; hell for the unsaved and heaven for the saved (John 14:1-3; Revelation 20:11-15).
10. **Satan** We believe that Satan is a fallen, created being who is the "god of this world". He and his well-organized company of demons are opposed to the Kingdom of God and work to defeat and destroy the believer. While his activity is real, Satan and his demon spirits were defeated and overthrown by Christ's victory at the cross (Luke 10:17-20; Colossians 2:13-15; Ephesians 6:10-18).
11. **Holy Spirit** We believe the Holy Spirit to be the third person of the Godhead who is active in the world today just as He was throughout the accountings of the Holy Scriptures. The Spirit indwells and seals the believer at new birth. We believe the Baptism in the Holy Spirit is a subsequent experience and is available to all Christians to empower us to be witnesses of the Gospel with signs and wonders following. We believe in, encourage, and embrace the active use of all the gifts of the Holy Spirit in every area of life (John 14:16-17; Acts 1:8, 2:1-4; I Corinthians 12:1-11).
12. **Ordinances** We believe that believer's Water Baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of the church and should be practiced regularly (Acts 2:38; Romans 6:3-10; I Corinthians 10:16-21).

Honor Statement

In order to uphold the highest Christian standards in obedience to the Word of God, PBI students are herein notified that any form of cheating, stealing, lying, including such actions as plagiarism, copying another student's work, or other forms of dishonesty are not acceptable as a part of the PBI education experience. Students caught engaging in any form of dishonest academic activity will be dealt with accordingly by the school's Dean of Academic Affairs and/or the President of the School. Calendar

Pneuma Bible Institute operates on a trimester system. The Spiritual Gifts Seminar, Part 1 of 4, is offered from April 11-June 6 and Parts 2-4 are offered Fall/Winter 2011-12. All other PBI Courses are offered from October 4, 2011 to June 7, 2012, with a winter break during the holidays. **No classes on:** November 22-24, and December 16, 2011 -January 9, 2012. Students' Certificate Award and Graduation Ceremony is June 21, 2012.

Enrollment Guidelines

In addition to the Application form, you must fill out a Course Registration form, and have a member of the clergy at your place of worship fill out a Clergy Recommendation form. This form can be returned separately from the Registration form and Application.

Application Overview & Process

Applications are welcome from students who have an academic background that indicates a potential for a successful undergraduate experience (minimum High School Diploma or GED) and who can contribute to the Christian ideals of PBI. While the potential for academic success is a primary consideration, a student's goals, the recommendations he/she submits, PBI's ability to serve the student are considered as well. Applications are accepted from any student without regard to race, color, national origin, creed, sex, age or handicap.

Application/ Course Registration

Each applicant must complete an Application for Admission and Course Registration Form.

Recommendation

Included in each application packet is a Clergy Recommendation form. Applicant needs to complete the top portion of the form with the rest being completed by an ordained minister; preferably by the pastor of the church where the applicant attends. The person completing the form should mail it directly to PBI.

Include with the completed application and registration form, a check or money order in the amount of \$50 payable to Bearers of Light Ministries. This amount is non-refundable.

Finances

Each student must pay a \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee, regardless of the number of courses taken in one trimester. The tuition is reasonable and subject to change. If a student takes more than one course in a trimester, a separate tuition fee is due for each course. Students must purchase a workbook for each course taken, at a cost of \$50.00 each.
